## **ADDENDUM**

Pursuant to paragraph 27(ii) of the attached SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT (the "Agreement"), the Plaintiffs and the Supervisors of Elections of the following five Florida Counties – Columbia, Jackson, Okeechobee, Taylor and Wakulla – enter into this addendum to the Agreement for the purpose of amending paragraph 16(g) of the Agreement as to Columbia, Jackson, Okeechobee, Taylor and Wakulla Counties only. For these five Counties, paragraph 16(g) of the Agreement is amended to read (added language <u>underlined</u>):

- g. Provide access to a county-specific hotline to assist Spanish-speaking voters during:
  - i. All early-voting hours;
  - ii. All hours when polling places are open on election day; and
  - iii. All hours after election day during which voters may cure voteby-mail and provisional-ballot deficiencies.

This item (g) is satisfied if the Supervisor:

(1) Makes reasonable, good-faith efforts to staff the hotline at all required times; and

(2) Provides an alternative translation service <u>or provides access to</u>

the Florida Secretary of State's Spanish Hotline to the extent that,
despite those efforts, the Supervisor is unable to staff the <u>county-specific</u> hotline at all required times.

A mistranslation by an alternative translation service is not a breach of this Agreement and does not give rise to liability on the part of the Supervisor.
