

NYC Council Districting Timeline

Date	Action
January 1, 2022	Mayor Adams is sworn into office
By or before January 7, 2022	Mayor convenes meeting of appointing authorities (majority and minority Council delegation) to establish screening and selection process for Districting Commission members and to ensure that racial and ethnic minority groups are fairly represented on the commission.
Between March 7, 2022 - May 7, 2022	Council delegations make their appointments to the Districting Commission
By June 7, 2022	Mayor makes his appointments to the Districting commission after each Council delegation has done so.
By or before September 9, 2022	Districting Commission shall make its initial districting plan available to the public
By or before October 8, 2022	Districting Commission shall hold one or more public hearings
By or before November 7, 2022	Districting Commission must submit initial plan to City Council
By November 28, 2022	Plan submitted by Districting Commission is either deemed adopted or majority of Council objects to the plan and submits written objections to the Commission
By or before January 7, 2023	If initial districting plan is met with a resolution of objection by the Council, the Commission shall submit a revised districting plan to the Council and make such plan available to the public by this date.
After submission of second districting plan by January 7, 2023	Commission shall hold additional public hearings and seek public comment on the revised plan.
By or before March 7, 2023	Commission shall submit final plan for redistricting to the Council
November 7, 2023	NYC Council Election
January 6, 2024	Districting Commission disbands
